We are also grateful for the opportunity to fund projects through the Cooperative Response Grant. At the time of this newsletter, we have supported 6 ecumenical projects around the state with a total of \$5,250. The projects range from Thanksgiving meals and backpack food programs, to expanding Meals on Wheels and planting fall crops in a community garden.
