We are excited to share that Festival of Sharing has funding available to partner with Missouri churches and organizations in efforts to cooperatively respond to community needs around poverty. We recognize that poverty is multidimensional and experienced in different ways and that local knowledge and collaboration can make a big impact. We hope to support communities as they work together to create healthy and successful lives for neighbors.

Responses must include at least two churches partnering from different denominational backgrounds and may work to address concerns beyond economic resources, to include such things as physical, social, cultural or spiritual resources. Applications are accepted on a rolling basis and grants will be awarded up to \$1,000. More details can be found on the application on our Resource page.

#### **Improving Hygiene Kits**

Festival of Sharing is working to make its hygiene items more inclusive of all types of skin and hair. You might have noticed a change in the Missouri Personal Hygiene Pack contents from "bar soap" to "moisturizing bar soap." This is one small step to offer comfort to more skin types. Agencies in Missouri helped us compile a list of lotion and Black hair products. This year we invite you to donate these individual items through our warehouse or Sharefests, and they will be shared with agencies based on their local need. Currently, we anticipate opening our locations back up for volunteers to join for various activities such as packing rice, tying fleece blankets and assembling kits. #### **Church World Service**

Earlier this summer we had the opportunity to partner with CWS, the Ferncliff Camp and Conference Center and the Missouri Annual Conference to collect Welcome Backpacks for refugees and asylum seekers. The backpacks include essential items like healthy snacks, a reusable water bottle, a few basic hygiene items, a blanket and more. The backpacks were taken to Ferncliff's warehouse outside of Little Rock, AR where they are prepared for shipment across the U.S. as CWS responds to refugee and resettlement needs. CWS currently collects Welcome Backpacks all year. If you would like to join this effort, you can turn backpacks in at any Sharefest this fall, or visit cwsglobal.org/donate/welcome-backpacks/ to donate \$75 for a backpack to be assembled. A list of kit contents is also available on that page.

CWS and UMCOR (United Methodist Committee On Relief) are partnering to collect relief supplies and have launched a new kit this summer! The Period Pack will help provide support to vulnerable menstruating populations and will be distributed during disasters, whether natural or socio-economic. The kits are valued at \$14 and include hand sanitizer, trash bags, sanitary napkins and more. We will accept donations of Period Packs at 2022 events.
