



Instructions: Please place items in the bags. Canvas bags can be made or purchased locally. If you are unable to buy or make the bags, you can email or call our office to receive pre-made bags donated by churches. Place kits in sturdy boxes and label **"CWS School Kit"** and number of kits.

- 1—12x14 up to 14x17 finished size cotton or light-weight canvas bag w/cloth handles (unable to accept bags with logos)
- 3 – 70 count spiral notebooks or notebooks totaling 200-210 pages (no loose-leaf or filler paper)
- 1 hand-held pencil sharpener (remove packaging)
- 1 pair of blunt metal scissors (rounded tip)
- 1 large eraser (no pencil cap erasers)
- 1 box of 24 ct. crayons (only 24)
- 1 – 30 cm ruler (12 inch)
- 6 new unsharpened pencils with erasers (remove packaging)

Instructions: Place all items in a 1-gallon plastic bag with zipper closure, remove excess air from bag and seal. Please do not add toothpaste to the hygiene kit, cartons that have an extended expiration date will be added to hygiene kit shipments just prior to shipment. Place kits in sturdy boxes and label "**CWS Hygiene Kits**" and the number of kits included.

- 1 washcloth
- 1 toothbrush (in original package)
- 1 bar of soap (bath size in package)
- 10 standard size Band-Aids®
- 1 wide-tooth comb (remove packaging)
- 1 nail clippers (remove packaging)
- 1 hand towel 15x28 to 16x32
(no fingertip, bath, or microfiber towels)

Instructions: All cleaning items must be new — all liquid items must be capped and securely tightened. Place all items into the bucket, making sure they are packed securely to avoid damage during shipment. Snap the lid on tight and seal with packing tape.

- 1 bucket with resealable lid (5-gallon only)
(clean out any used buckets well but do not use if it has held chemicals of any kind at any time)
- 24-48 heavy-duty or contractor trash bags sized 30-45 gallon in roll (remove cardboard packaging)
- 18 reusable cleaning wipes (i.e. easy wipes)
- 1 bottle of liquid household cleaner (12-16 oz.)
Must be water mixable. (no spray bottles)
- 1 non aerosol insect repellent (6-9 oz.)
- 1 scrub brush (plastic or wooden)
- 2 pairs non-surgical latex gloves. Should be durable for multiple uses. (remove packaging)
- 1 – 50-oz. or 2 – 25-oz. Liquid laundry detergent (bottle(s) only)
- 1 pair work gloves Cotton with leather palm or all leather.
- 7 sponges, including 1 large sponge
- Clothesline 1–100-ft. or 2–50-ft. lines
- 48-50 clothespins
- 4 scouring pads
- 5 dust masks
